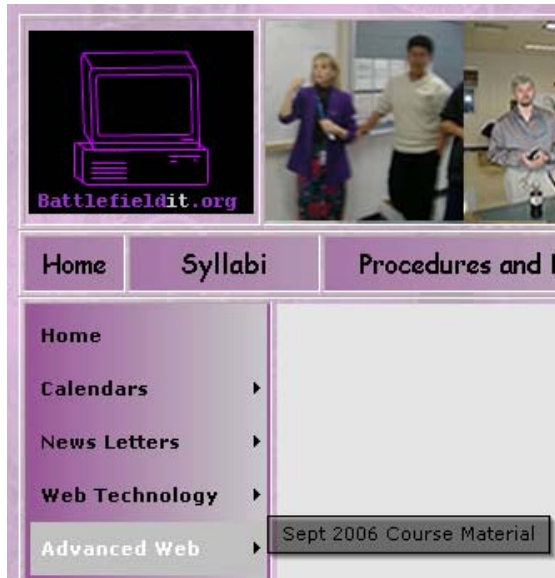
First bell is at 7:13. The First Class starts at 7:20. The students will say the pledge, have one minute of silence, and then have announcements. Turn the television to Channel 35.

## Wednesday Policy: First Block:

1. “Read to Succeed” for the first 20 minutes of class. Students are to READ on the computer, and they are to read about something new with Information Technology. At the end of “Read to Succeed” have each student review out loud to the entire class what they read about.
2. All other students are to be quiet during this time. If the student presents what they read and DID NOT be rude while others spoke, then give them full credit. Otherwise note, read but rude, did not read and not rude, did not read and rude.
3. Make next to the names above the results of each student.
4. Remainder of class, the students can work on their programming assignments

## Substitute Teacher:

1. **Inform the students to follow the class schedule using the Class Website. They will ALL know exactly how to do this ! Complete all work with the exception of the lecture.**
2. **For your convenience, the process follows:**
